Don Hewitt : Creator, "60 Minutes"

Hewitt's many awards include eight Emmy Awards, two George Foster Peabody Awards, and the 1980 Broadcaster of the Year Award from the International Radio and Television Society. Hewitt was inducted into the Television Academy Hall of Fame in 1990.

Among Hewitt's many honors are the second annual Lifetime Achievement Emmy presented by the National Academy of Television Arts and Sciences, the American Federation of Television and Radio Actors George Heller Lifetime Achievement Award (May 2003), and the Spirit Award, a lifetime achievement award from the National Association of Broadcasters (April 2003).

Beginning his career with CBS News in 1948, Hewitt was an associate director of "Douglas Edwards with the News." He eventually served as producer-director of the broadcast for 14 years. Later, Hewitt became executive producer of the "CBS Evening News with Walter Cronkite."
